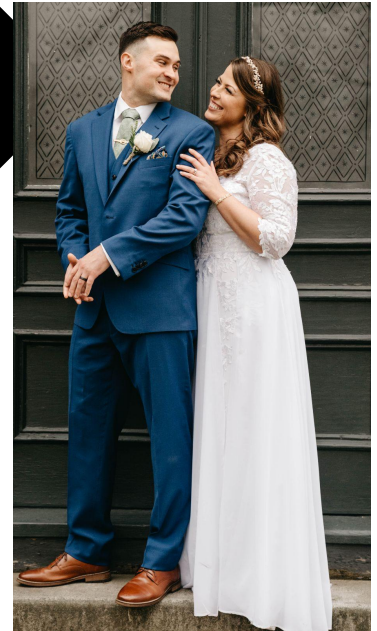


WELCOME TO 5TH GRADE!
